As such, we are concerned about the recent filing of a lawsuit by Planned Parenthood against the state of Wisconsin where you are named a defendant.

In an October 9, 2018, article in the *Milwaukee Journal Sentinel* you stated, "I think the AG's job is to defend state statutes and state agency actions if there is a legally defensible position to take."

Are you able to stand by this statement you made? If you are not able to, then do you have plans to recuse yourself and department from defending this lawsuit?

I understand that during your campaign for Wisconsin Attorney General you were endorsed by Planned Parenthood of Wisconsin. It appears that you would have a clear conflict of interest in representing the State of Wisconsin when the plaintiff in the case actively supported your campaign to your elected position.

It is my understanding that there will be a limited time frame of when others can intervene in this lawsuit. I am available at your earliest convenience to meet with you and your team in person.
